AOI will primarily assist with the implementation of America's Blood Centers' AIM software, which includes AIM-I, a tool that helps hospitals and blood centers manage blood product inventory, and AIM-II, a solution that aggregates patient data to track blood utilization and patient outcomes.

In addition, AOI will work directly with America's Blood Centers' member organizations to create a standardized format across all member databases to achieve direct communication with the Data Warehouse. Once data is exchanged, participating blood centers will be able to leverage more than 180 utilization and patient outcome reports and dashboards for analysis, tracking, trending and benchmarking.
