Dear Speaker Johnson, Majority Leader Thune, Minority Leader Jeffries, Minority Leader Schumer,

As we enter Blood Advocacy Week 2025, over 100 organizations are joining forces to urge action in support of our nation's blood supply. We encourage you to prioritize our nation's blood supply and take key steps to ensure that blood is always available for every patient in need. This includes taking the following steps:

- 1. Time is of the essence when it comes to blood transfusions following traumatic injuries. One study found up to five percent increased odds of mortality for every minute of delay in access to blood. However, without sufficient reimbursement for the cost of having blood available for patients in need, Emergency Medical Services (EMS) cannot provide life-saving transfusions. I urge you to support report language to the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) to update TRICARE payment policy to remove financial barriers and allow for broader adoption of prehospital blood transfusions, supporting TRICARE's mission to improve the health of the military and their families which, in turn, helps support the security of the United States.
- 2. Blood centers are the lifeblood of our nation's healthcare system, ensuring a safe and sufficient blood supply for patients in need. These vital organizations serve our health care system, supporting everything from routine surgeries to emergency trauma responses. Yet, in an increasingly digital world, blood centers face a new and formidable challenge: sophisticated cyberattacks. Recent incidents have exposed the vulnerability of these critical institutions to malicious actors, with potentially devastating consequences, including disruptions to blood collection and distribution processes, cancelation of elective surgeries, delays in non-emergency patient care due to diminished blood supplies, significant financial losses, and operational setbacks. To address this urgent issue, I urge you to support robust funding for the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) and ensure blood centers are considered in efforts to ensure health care information technology infrastructure is strengthened to prevent potential attacks.
- 3. Government regulations impose unnecessary and burdensome barriers on blood centers. By implementing changes to these regulations, we can enhance blood product availability for patients in need, reduce unnecessary costs and resource allocations, and support innovation in blood banking and

transfusion medicine. To modernize America's blood supply chain, save more lives, and improve healthcare outcomes across the nation, we ask that you urge the Administration to cut red tape and remove burdensome barriers, including streamlining licensure for new donation sites, modernizing testing requirements to match modern testing technology, maximizing the platelet donations that can be used for patient care, and increasing plasma regulation flexibility.
